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***AWARD CRITERIA***

- ✓ The applicant must be a Canadian Citizen, a Permanent Resident of pan-northern Ontario during the treatment period.
- ✓ The applicant must be a survivor of childhood cancer or the sibling of a child diagnosed with childhood cancer.
- ✓ The applicant must be enrolled in an accredited post-secondary program.  
**Academic marks are not a factor for the bursary.**

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***APPLICATION / SELECTION PROCESS***

Applicants are required to submit the following:

- A letter sharing the applicant's story telling how childhood cancer has affected his/her life;
- A completed Application Form, including the signed "Applicant's Consent to Release Information";
- Proof of registration at a post-secondary institution (letter from Registrar); and
- Proof of diagnosis.

The selection will be made by the NOFCC Selection Committee. Completed application packages are to be post-marked no later than August 31<sup>st</sup> each year.

**Note:** An individual can receive the bursary only once during his/her post-secondary education. If not selected in one year, a person may apply for succeeding years. A new Application Form and Proof of Registration are the only two items required for successive applications.

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***AWARD PRESENTATION***

The selection process will be completed and the announcement of successful recipients' names made by the end of September each year.

Successful recipients will be informed of presentation arrangements.
