It is with much excitement that the NOFCC and Vale INCO announce the inception of 'The Shine Bright Bursary' program devised to offer some financial assistance to all northern Ontario children dealing with childhood cancer and their siblings enrolled in a post-secondary institution.

Since childhood cancer affects the whole family: emotionally, socially, and financially, the NOFCC along with Vale INCO is making available to survivors of childhood cancer, their siblings along with the siblings of children who have succumbed to cancer the opportunity to apply to this innovative program.

Starting in the fall of 2010, young adults who are enrolled full-time in a post-secondary program and who have applied for The Shine Bright Bursary may receive some financial help to offset the cost of: tuition fees, books & supplies, or any other educational related expenses which must be incurred by students throughout the school year.

The NOFCC is extremely grateful to Vale Inco for their generous donations toward The Shine Bright Bursary and our KeepConnected Program; therefore, helping the NOFCC accomplish an objective set forth years ago to offer as much support as possible to our northern families.
